SUBJECT: Call for Nominations and Broadening Assignments for the Fiscal Year 2019-2020  
President's Management Council Interagency Rotation Program, Cohort 17

SUSPENSE: Nominations due by June 3, 2019

ACTION: Review, disseminate, and submit nominations and broadening assignments

BACKGROUND/INTENT: This is a call for nominations and broadening assignments for the Fiscal Year 2019-2020 Office of Personnel Management's President's Management Council Interagency Rotation Program (PMC IRP). This is a 6-month, interagency broadening opportunity, for eligible high-caliber employees in the grades of General Schedule (GS) 13 through GS-15 or equivalent. Cohort 17 will commence September 30, 2019, and end March 27, 2020. Submit all nominations and broadening assignments to Ms. Pamela Boteler.

For each individual nominee, DoD Components, Agencies, and Field Activities participating in the PMC IRP must also provide two broadening opportunities for other Federal Agency participants. Broadening assignments offer participants the opportunity to enhance and/or develop two or three primary executive core qualifications. Assignments should provide opportunities such as a Senior Executive Service mentor, access and exposure to a senior-level meeting or shadowing experience, and project/program management experience. Components who submit nominees outside the metropolitan Washington, DC area are responsible for travel and per diem for their employees.

The DoD is allocated seven slots for Cohort 17, based on a projection of no more than 14 DoD offerings of rotational assignments. The Departments of the Army, Navy, and Air Force may each submit a maximum of three nominees for Cohort 17. The Office of the Under Secretary of Defense for Intelligence and all other Fourth Estate Agencies and Field Activities may submit one nominee each. Nominations must be approved by a Deputy Assistant Secretary or Equivalent senior level official.
