On _____ you arrived at Fort Bliss, Texas after having traveled from or through a CDC designated Travel Health Notice (THN) Level 2 or 3 country. Upon arrival at Fort Bliss you refused to voluntarily enter a 14-day quarantine period on Fort Bliss.

Since you have refused to voluntarily quarantine here on Fort Bliss, you are barred from physically entering the United States Military Reservation at Fort Bliss, Texas. I take this action in order to safeguard the health and welfare of Fort Bliss, and to ensure the safety of the Fort Bliss community. This quarantine is in response to the World Health Organization and the Secretary of Health and Human Services' declared public health emergency and the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) designation of certain High Risk Countries and the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19) outbreak. This order takes effect upon your receipt of this letter and remains in effect for 14 days.

There are no exceptions to this bar and it applies to both the United States Military Reservation at Fort Bliss, Texas and William Beaumont Army Medical Center (WBAMC) as well as any services offered on either Fort Bliss or WBAMC. Your information and status as one who has refused voluntary quarantine will be communicated to El Paso public health officials. Nothing in this order prevents you from telephonically contacting Army Public Health authorities for any reason, or reporting to WBAMC if directed by an Army medical provider.

Should you enter or be found within the limits of the United States Military Reservation at Fort Bliss, Texas or William Beaumont Army Medical Center in violation of this order, the Military Police will apprehend and deliver you to the appropriate civilian authorities.

Title 18 of the United States Code, Section 1382, states as follows:

Whoever, within the jurisdiction of the United States, goes upon any military, naval, or Coast Guard reservation, post, fort, arsenal, yard, station, or installation, for any purpose prohibited by law or lawful regulation; or

Whoever, reenters or is found within any such reservation, post, fort, arsenal, yard, station, or installation after having been removed there from or ordered not to enter by any officer or person in command or charge thereof, shall be fined under this title or imprisoned not more than six months, or both.


