

## Who can apply?

This program is open to all D.o.D. personnel.

There are no restrictions on who can be a mentor or a mentee. The right mentor is dependent on the specific needs of the mentee, so a more junior employee may be a mentor if they have a specific knowledge base or experience that is needed by the mentee, and a more senior employee may want to learn a new skill from a mentor that hasn't been here as long or is of a lower paygrade.

Based on each individual's application, mentors and mentees will be matched from what the mentor has to offer and what the mentee is seeking.

Supervisor approval and signature will be required for participation.

## How long is this program?

This is a 6-month program.

Roughly 1-2 hours a month time investment is required.

This program will allow mentees and mentors to form genuine relationships that will be mutually beneficial when addressing career interests and goals, networking, and sharing information about Fort Gregg-Adams employee resources.
