

Family Member Eligibility Verification Annual Report

ACTION REQUIRED: Submit FMEV Report to DCPAS NLT June 19, 2026

This is a reminder that all Components must submit their Family Member Eligibility Verification (FMEV) report in accordance with the requirements outlined in the Office of Personnel Management's (OPM) Benefits Administration Letter (BAL) 26-201.

Components are responsible for ensuring that dependent eligibility is properly verified and the work performed is reported. Please ensure your agency's 2025 Open Season, Initial Opportunity to Enroll, and Qualifying Life Event FMEV report is submitted to the Defense Civilian Personnel Advisory Service (DCPAS) **no later than June 19, 2026**. This allows for the consolidation and internal review of all Component reports.
