BACKGROUND/INTENT: The national emergency concerning the COVID-19 pandemic was declared by Presidential Proclamation 9994 on March 13, 2020, and was most recently extended on February 10, 2023 (reference a.). In this extension, President Biden announced that he anticipates terminating the national emergency concerning the COVID-19 pandemic on May 11, 2023. Components are encouraged to ensure that their re-entry plans are in place and that they take the required actions in accordance with the DSD memorandum as reference (b).
