BECOME A COACH THROUGH *FLATTER INC. CCFC

Complete the 16-week, 80-hour International Coach Federation (ICF) accredited Coaching Culture Facilitator Course (CCFC) and become a credentialed coach in the DAF Cadre and Coaching Community of Practice. Eligible Ranks: E-6 to E-9, O-3 to O-9, GS-09 to SES. Please note that, due to limited course seats, target ranks/grades are set by HAF.

BECOME A COACH THROUGH FICTP

Apply for the award-winning Federal Internal Coach Training Program. The FICTP program is recognized and accredited by ICF. Complete 136 hours of training over 7-8 months and become an ICF-credentialed coach. Eligible Ranks/Grades: GS-12/equivalent and above, O4 and above, E7 and above.
