- SUBJECT: 2024 Federal Employees Health Benefits Plan Choices Where the Enrollee Share of Self Plus One Premiums is Higher Than Self and Family
- AUDIENCE: Appropriated Fund Employees, Human Resources Offices, and Benefits Service Centers

ACTION: Disseminate to Department of Defense Human Resources Practitioners

REFERENCE: U.S. Office of Personnel Management (OPM) Report, "Plan Year 2024 - Self Plus One is Higher than Self and Family," October 5, 2023 (attached)

BACKGROUND/INTENT: On October 5, 2023, OPM issued the above referenced report identifying the Federal Employees Health Benefits (FEHB) Program Self Plus One enrollment types that have higher premiums than their corresponding Self and Family enrollment types. Each Open Season OPM issues this report to ensure employees are aware of the premium differences. It is important to note that employees seeking to cover only one family member may either elect a Self Plus One or a Self and Family enrollment type. Therefore, it is in their best interest to elect the Self and Family enrollment type when Self Plus One is at a higher premium.

For the 2024 plan year, there are 48 FEHB plan choices where the enrollee share of premiums for the Self Plus One enrollment type is higher than Self and Family. The attached OPM report lists these plan choices and their premiums. The report contains columns to highlight the difference in premiums per pay period and for the year. Enrollees can experience significant savings depending on the plan, so please share this information with your employees.

Employees should carefully review the 2024 premium rates at <u>https://www.opm.gov/healthcare-insurance/healthcare/plan-information/premiums/</u> for their current plan and any other plan choices they are considering. As a reminder, changes may be made this Open Season, which is from November 13 through December 11, 2023.
