Joel T. Alexander is the Regional Director and Chief Administrative Judge for the Dallas Regional Office of the U.S. Merit Systems Protection Board (MSPB). Previously, he served as an Administrative Judge in the MSPB's Office of Regional Operations and Dallas Regional Office. Before his appointment at the MSPB, he worked for the Department of Homeland Security, U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE), as an attorney specializing in labor and employment law. Before joining ICE, Judge Alexander represented employees, including farm workers, in labor and employment law matters in North Carolina.

Judge Alexander received a Bachelor of Science degree in Computer Engineering from North Carolina State University, and a Juris Doctor degree from the University of North Carolina School of Law. He is admitted to the bar in North Carolina and Texas. Judge Alexander is a returned Peace Corps volunteer previously stationed in Papua New Guinea, and he received a Fulbright Fellowship to teach law at the University of Asmara in Eritrea.
